APPEARANCES: Parties are representing themselves.

COURT: Judgment

The Claimant is claiming the sum of ₦300,000.00 (Three Hundred Thousand Naira) from the Defendant being a sum of money he paid the defendant for a purchase of the Defendant's shop.

The sum of ₦2,150 was also claimed by the Claimant as Court fees and ₦200,000.00 cost.

On the 27/6/2024 when the matter came up for plea, the Defendant opted to settle the matter with the defendant out of Court. The matter was adjourned to the 12/7/2024 for report of settlement. On the said 12/7/2024, the Claimant informed the Court that he has settled the matter with the Defendant and they have an agreement signed which he wants the Court to adopt same as the Judgment of the Court. The Claimant testified on oath and stated the terms of settlement to wit: that the Defendant has agreed to pay him the sum of ₦300,000.00 from now till the end of December, 2024 and that the Defendant has given him his generator to keep and where the

Defendant cannot pay between now and December, 2024, the generator shall become his own and this was reduced into writing. Having given the parties opportunity to go and settle this matter, I am convinced that the parties have settled. The terms of settlement headed as an "**Agreement**" is hereby admitted by this Court and same is adopted as the Judgment in this suit. It is and hereby ordered that Judgment be and hereby entered in favour of the Claimant in the following terms: The Defendant shall pay to the Claimant the sum of ₦300,000.00 (Three Hundred Thousand Naira) on or before the 31st day of December, 2024. Failure to liquidate this debt, the Defendant's generator now in the custody of the Claimant shall become the sole property of the Claimant. This is the Judgment of the Court.
